Exodus 11-12

Getting Started:

Share something of your background that influences who you are today

Pray for understanding as we read God's word.

What is God saying?

Read Exodus 11:1-10

What does the LORD promise will happen now to Pharaoh and Egypt?

And to Israel?

Read Exodus 12:1-16, 24-30

What preparations are the Israelite's to make?

How should these be remembered in the future?

How is the LORD's promise kept?

Why is God saying this?

How does Israel's enslavement foreshadow our own? (Read also Ephesians 2:1-3)

How does the way of salvation from slavery to worshipping the LORD foreshadow our own in Christ? (Recall the last supper from Luke 22 we read last term)

How important is remembering our discipleship roots, and how do they shape how we live now?

Prayer Starters

- Thank God for his grace to us given through judgement
- Praise God for the Lord Jesus, our substitute, whose blood was shed for us
- Ask God's Spirit may shape our lives in the way of humble obedience
